- 12 to 15 sheets watercolor paper or canvas at least 9 x 12". Larger if you wish.
- Newsprint and printer paper. Newsprint may have print on it.
- Black and white tissue paper such as

- Gelli plate 8 x 10" or 9 x 12". This brand is nice because it is thicker than some others:

- Brayer
- Blockprinting cutter and 1 or more Speedy-carve blocks

- Glue gun with glue sticks (optional)
- Stencils (optional)
- At least 5 favorite colors acrylic paint. You may work with acrylics of any kind (inks, fluid, heavy body, etc.)
- White gesso and/or white acrylic paint
- Mat Medium (any brand)
- Gel Medium if you wish to collage heavier papers such as watercolor papers
- Palette for acrylics (I will show you several home-made items that work well)
- Spray water bottle
- Water bucket
- Terry towels or paper towels
- Old paintings, pages from books, music manuscript, old letters, ephemera
- Markers, watercolor or ink pens, oil pastels, any medium you'd like to experiment with

- If you haven't painted/collaged with acrylics before, you might want to cover your work space and wear clothing so you can a little get messy. That's part of the fun.
