Volunteer of the Month Judith Lutkus



Each month, we'd like to recognize one of our many volunteers,

Our first nominee is Judith Lutkus. Judy has been a member of WAS-H since she moved back to Texas in 2020. She has been volunteering twice a month, helping manage our Member Sales Gallery since it opened in November 2021. In addition, she is often the person who watches the Gallery when the Artist Liaison is away.

Judy graduated with a Sociology degree from the Connecticut College for Women. While there, she also began her studies in art. After graduation, she married her husband, Tony, and became a military spouse. Tony was in the Coast Guard, so they moved around the country and started their family.

"While the children were young, I stayed home with them. Once they

were in school, I was able to start painting again. I took classes and workshops wherever we landed and started volunteering to get involved in the community," Judy explains.

Judy and Tony had three children; two boys, Tony Jr. and Stephen, and one adopted girl, Nicole. "My parents supported a Catholic orphanage in Vietnam for many years, so I knew there were children who needed a good home; this is why we adopted Nicole, a child at that orphanage."

Once Tony left the military, he worked for Exxon and moved the family overseas. They lived in Norway, London, and Malaysia during Tony's Exxon career. "I continued to take art classes and workshops and volunteer. I volunteered for several years at the Royal Academy of Art."

Judy and Tony returned to Houston in 2020. They selected Houston because of its central location. "We wanted to be in a big city where it would be easy to travel. We need to visit the grandchildren!" Their children live in New Jersey, California, and Florida - so the Texas location was perfect!
