Guadalupe Hernandez was our judge for the show, currently an Artist-in-Residence with the Houston Center for

Contemporary Craft. His practice examines themes of family, labor, and cultural practices through a series of paintings and works of cut paper inspired by the traditional Mexican craft of Papel Picado. Recently he was notably among six pairs of visual artists in the 2022 US Latinx Art Forum Mentorship Program supporting an intergenerational skill exchange. He will also serve as the 2023/2024 Visiting Artist of Color at The Art Students League of Denver in the fall.

Judge: "Interesting use of multiple techniques. Dry brushing of the light and dark. Sharp/clean and blurred edges (boats), soft edges. Nice read from a distance."
