Paintings will remain in the virtual gallery until August 6, 2021

Juror: Ksenia Annis was born in Soviet Russia and educated to be an architect, a career that she pursued for 20 years in Russia and the U.S. However, in 2009, her primary passion to be a profession artist won her over. She dedicated the next few years to systematic studies of drawing and painting, and in 2014, founded her company, Tummy Rubb Studio. She has created paintings, illustrations, and public art projects. Her primary focus now is teaching art classes in water media (watercolor, gouache and acrylic). Ksenia is an active member, and valuable volunteer and teacher at WAS-H.

Eligibility and Requirements:

- Work done under teacher supervision is permitted for this show only
- Members who have been awarded a 1st, 2nd, 3rd place in any previous WAS-H exhibit are NOT ELIGIBLE to enter student show
- Members who have had artwork juried into an AME or IWE exhibit are NOT ELIGIBLE to enter student show
- Artist must be a current WAS-H member
- Artwork must be completed within the last 24 months
- Up to three entries per artist.
- Fee of \$10 per entry

Teacher Appreciation

- Teachers are invited to exhibit one painting each that will be displayed but will not be part of the judging.
- No entry fee required for teacher paintings exhibited in this show.
- Works may be offered for sale.

Artwork Regulations:

Water soluble media

At least 80% water media: watercolor, acrylic, gouache, egg tempera, casein, or ink

Surfaces

Paper, Yupo, Claybord, Gessobord (with or without cradle), illustration or art board, rice paper, or canvas

Originality

Photo references allowed:

- Permission-granted photos taken by others
- Photos no longer copyrightprotected
- Purchased photos
- Artist's own photos

Paintings:

- NOT painted from another's painting, other than compositions created in class by a credited instructor
- NOT repainted from winning image
- Only original artwork (no giclees, copies, etc.)

Collage

- Allowed as long as water media is the dominant element,
- No restrictions on collage source (ie fabric, commercial papers, photos, etc, allowed)

Enhancement Media

- Less than 20% watercolor pencils, pastels, wax accents/resists, char coal, graphite, water based iridescent paints

Pricing

- Paintings may be for sale or not for sale (NFS)
- Paintings will have sales tax added at time of sale
- Gallery commission of 20% and 5% charge for credit card sales

Matting and Framing Regulations

- Paintings do not have to be matted or framed for an online show
- No varnished paintings
- Size not to exceed 48" in height or width

Unclothed figure

- Yes, this subject allowed
- WAS-H reserves the right to refuse entries that are obscene, controversial, or in bad taste

Awards

- Cash Awards for 1st- \$100, 2nd - \$75 and 3rd- \$50
- Honorable Mentions awarded a ribbon - no cash
- Only one award per artist
- Winners are notified by phone and/or email

Regulation

- Artwork will not physically hang in the gallery for this online exhibit
- A photo of the artwork will be submitted and posted on the WAS-H website, as is done for the WAS-H International Exhibit.
- A photograph of the painting must remain in the virtual gallery for the duration of the exhibit
